

Euglobulin Clot Lysis Time: Cessation of Testing

To: Interlakes Oncology Providers

Effective Date: April 26, 2021

As of April 26, 2021, **Euglobulin Clot Lysis Time** testing at UR Medicine Laboratories will be discontinued for the reasons listed below. Euglobulin Clot Lysis Time is available through reference laboratories with a turnaround time of 3-8 days. The specimen requirements for this testing vary from the current testing and may be prohibitive. See the link below for more information.

Reasons:

- 1. Proficiency testing (PT) material through our PT provider(s) is no longer available.
- 2. There is a lack of demand for this testing. In 2019 and 2020 there was at most one request per month making it very difficult for our laboratory to maintain staff competency.
- 3. There is a good alternative to this test in the Thromboelastography (TEG) test.
